

Pewter thimble makers of the world with their marks

When I created the topic Marks on British silver thimbles, in 2002 I never dreamt it would be the most visited section in my Learn More About ... Thimbles topics. I am hoping to fill a gap that has long existed in creating a similar database for pewter marks – this time from around the world. Maybe it too can become the source for thimble marks on pewter?

Pewter thimbles began to appear for the thimble collectables market – ie thimbles not made to sew with – in the late 1970s. That and the following decade were the heyday for the makers and collectors of this medium. Many were handpainted, had figures atop (also known as toppers). Now we can look back on 100,000s of pewter thimbles!

According to Edwin Holmes, pewter is an alloy of tin (93.6%) lead, copper and antimony is it known as poor man's silver. Modern pewter thimbles are lead-free. Pewter is a soft malleable medium ideal for sculpting in fine detail, with the sculptor or designer limited only by his imagination and much it is cheaper than silver. Pewter thimbles are mostly too heavy to be used for sewing.

Being a darker medium than silver, pewter thimble marks are more difficult to photograph. The great majority of pewter thimbles are unmarked. If we are lucky, the thimble has remained with its presentation box, where the maker's marks may be gleaned.

I have included all names that have come to my attention thru selling thimbles of every variety over the last 35 years and those mentioned in thimble catalogues from 1970. I am interested to hear from you please if your country's pewter makers don't appear here.

Looking back thru the thimble catalogues of the 1970s and 80s, confusion may arise as the sellers were loath to reveal the thimble makers' names for fear of competition. Sometimes they used just the sculptor's name (ie John Ball) and not the firm for whom he worked (McMillan & Wife). By creating this database, we may be able to link one or more makers and sculptors or designers from one stable together?

I have concentrated on listing makers of thimbles wholly made of pewter. Sterling Classic, who have created many pewter pieces for placement on top of their china thimbles, are not included here.

Nor will you find makers of wooden thimbles with pewter items affixed, nor resin, nor glass.

Swarovski crystals may be included as part of the design as long as pewter is primary.

Do you know who created the fire-hydrant thimbles with enamel discs affixed?

As in the previous topic I created, Pewter character head thimbles, I noticed a far greater use of the copyright symbol © on the pewter thimbles listed. This mark never occurs on sterling silver thimbles; it is infrequently found on china thimbles. I have recorded it when I found a copyright mark on pewter thimbles.

I have noticed many identical pewter thimbles – from differing manufacturers. This database hopes to link these sculptors thru their various paths. Warwick Model's Stephen Frost carried the moulds with him from McMillan & Wife (such a name from the early 80s wouldn't be used today?) when they closed. Many thimbles are articulated, some hinged, or having moving parts.

I was intrigued to find an extra British mark on pewter thimbles that I'd never noticed before: **ABPC** for the Association of British Pewter Craftsmen.

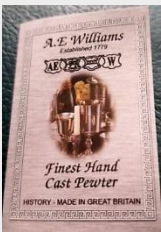
It is not a maker's mark. The mark may accompany a maker's mark.

I have included this mark in the alphabetical listing and when it has been used.

One example of each thimble is included, with a purely descriptive title. As I launch this topic, there are **127** makers represented.
