

Henry Griffith & Sons sterling silver thimbles made with other sponsor's marks

From Victorian times onwards it was the norm that the bigger British thimble making firms were commissioned to make thimbles on behalf of sponsors, using the sponsor's maker's mark instead of their own. In 2020 I listed those made by Charles Horner, who made thimbles on behalf of 36 sponsors. From this small survey it seems as if Horner were the more well-known maker as the sponsors who chose them, had many designs made for them over the years.

It is now the turn of another of the big four British thimble makers to have their thimble output examined: Henry Griffith of Birmingham. I have found **21** examples of where their thimbles were made for other sponsors.

Henry Griffith & Sons (HG&S or HG&S Ltd) mainly used the Birmingham assay office and occasionally the Chester assay office. How can we distinguish which thimbles were made by CH or HGS? The answer lies in the thimble size numbers. Griffith was the only thimble maker who used the millimetre diameter as his size mark (ie 11 is their smallest size thru to the huge 20).

Griffith didn't always send their thimbles for assaying – preferring to use MADE IN ENGLAND or THE SPA. They didn't use these terms on thimbles made on commission.
